



**In the past, parents have asked for suggestions regarding their role in the education process. Because of this, we have created a quick list of ways that you can support your child this year.**

- Ask your child about what he/she learned each day.
- Check Infinite Campus once a week to view your child's progress.
- Check Duflo's and Thelen's separate websites so you can see upcoming learning targets, virtual newsletters, and subject-area resources.
- Periodically ask your child to show you his/her subject area notebook/ folder/binder to make sure it is organized.
- If needed, help your child plan a reader calendar to make sure that he/she is staying on top of the AR goal.
- Help your child make flashcards to review for future learning checks or concepts that need extra practice.
- Google search for websites that may aid your child in understanding concepts/skills that he/she has yet mastered.
- When helping your child edit a writing piece, always have him/her by your side. Explain corrections as you note them. Try to choose one or two areas to focus on (example: complete sentences, comma use, or details).
