

# Preposition Notes

A **preposition** is one or more words that are placed before a noun or pronoun to describe how it is related to something else. It may tell the POSITION of an object in reference to something else.

For example, in the sentence *The remote control is next to the television*, the words **next to** is a preposition, describing the location where the remote control can be found. Prepositions are **often used to provide the specifics, having to do with placement, direction, or time.**
