<p>Who is the <u>S</u>peaker?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Who voice that is speaking? ❖ What can we infer about the person? ❖ What roles does he play in this event?
<p>What is the <u>O</u>ccasion?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ What is the time and place? ❖ What is the source of the literature...that created it?
<p>Who is the <u>A</u>udience?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ To whom is this document directed? ❖ The audience may be one person, a small group, or a large group, or specific to a person or group.
<p>What is the <u>P</u>urpose?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ What is the reason behind the text? ❖ Why was it written? ❖ What goal did the author have in mind?
<p>What is the <u>S</u>ubject?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ What is the general topic, content, or idea contained in the text? ❖ Summarize in a few words or phrases.
<p>What is the <u>TONE</u>?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ What is the attitude expressed by the speaker? ❖ Examine the choice of words, emotions expressed, imagery used to determine the speaker's attitude.
